SALARY:

\$15.62/hour (maximum 960 hours)

WHO CAN APPLY:

Any college student (degree and non-degree seeking), law student, and/or graduate student is eligible to apply.

Proof of college enrollment in the last semester/quarter of this school year (2017) and proof of at least 30 college units/credits is required.

Interns must be able to work a minimum of 15-25 hours per week, and may not work more than 40 hours per week.
